大家好，欢迎收听 BBC 英语教学的“地道英语”节目。我是冯菲菲。

What are you talking about?

Roy

You sent me a message saying you had lots of pizzas, so I'm ready to eat!

No, Roy. I said I had real pizzazz, not pizzas! I was saying how glamorous I was.

I think the colour scheme on your painting is so vibrant. It has real pizzazz.

The moment I listened to the song for the first time, I couldn't stop dancing to it! The tune has real energy and pizzazz.
