### Jiaying

### Jiaying

Not Anubis, Roy – I called you a noob. 名词“noob – n o o b”的意思是“菜鸟，新手”，指“对某件事情不熟悉且缺乏经验的人”。

Oh... then you're just really bad at it! 你还得再练几次才能提高水平啊！

Maybe we could play again? I have no idea how you found the dragon so early. You didn't watch a gamer's tips and tricks video, did you?

### Jiaying

Well, maybe just one video – it's good to research what you're going to play. Let's have another game while we listen to these examples.

Four years ago, I made a film. It was terrible – I was such a noob! So, I studied how to make films at university.

So, do you want to play another game?

## Jiaying

No, thanks. I prefer playing against newbies so I can win. Bye, Roy!
