Jiaying

Neil – what's wrong? You look a little sad!

Neil

Well, earlier, the owner of the local coffee shop laughed at me! She said that my purple suit made me look ridiculous – she said I looked like a big grape!

Jiaying

Well, I hope you clapped back!

Neil

I certainly did not! I just bought my coffee and left. Why would I clap her horrible comment? I don't want to applaud it!

Yes, you should have clapped back with that! But now let's listen to these examples.

Examples

When she said his sponge cake wasn't nice, he clapped back and said she made bad cups of tea.

Don't clap back at me! I wasn't trying to criticise you when I said you need to change your t-shirt!

She clapped back by telling him he was the worst driver in the world.

Jiaying

Good! Anyway, I'm going to go and listen to some music. Bye, Neil!

OK, I'll get some earplugs. Bye!
